As part of our Enquiry “What is home?” we have been looking at British wildlife around our homes and have organised a visitor to come and talk to the children about hedgehogs on Tuesday 28th September. The Hedgehog Rescue is a volunteer-run hedgehog hospital and the co-ordinator, Yvonne Cox will talk to the children about the care, treatment and rehabilitation of over 300 hedgehogs every year; many of which are successfully re-released with the help of their network of volunteers. Weather permitting, she will be bringing hedgehogs with her for the children to look at outside.

All money raised from talks, adoptions, donations and sales go to help pay for food, cages and medication.
